English

- Fantasy stories - using the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S. Lewis as a stimulus for imaginative writing. Children will use an array of resources, such as visual materials and word banks, to build their own descriptions about various aspects of the story, including: the wardrobe, the characters and Mr Tumnus' home. The final aim is to create a writing piece whereby children develop their own wardrobe to step inside.
