Science

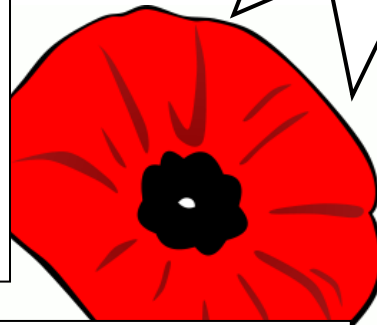
