### Science

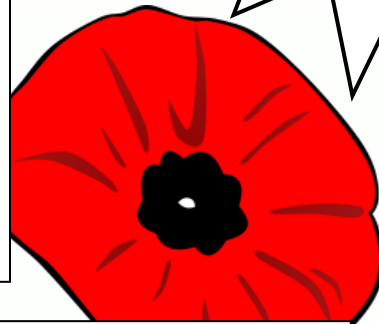
