<p>Write</p> <p>Your own play script set about Mai-Ling and the volcano.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Devise your own menu plan for the family meals for one week. Think about a balanced diet and write out the food you will eat for each meal, each day. Keep it varied and interesting for the whole family. You can include “treats” and remember to include the drinks and snacks you will have.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Look at your shopping bill for a week (all the food that you eat). Calculate the cost of the food for a month. Don’t forget the basics like bread, milk, butter, cheese, vegetables and fruit!</p>	<p>Research</p> <p>Can you find out about volcanoes that are currently active?</p> <p>OR</p> <p>What can you find out about Vesuvius and Pompeii? Use purple mash to help you. You could present your findings as a poster, PowerPoint or in any creative way you like.</p>
	<p>Make</p> <p>Can you make your own volcano model? You could base it on an existing volcano. You could even make it explode!</p>	<p>Be imaginative!</p> <p>Create your own task and see where your learning takes you.</p>
