### Maths

- Number and place value - ordering numbers beyond 1000, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, Roman Numerals
- Statistics - recording and interpreting information in tables, presenting data in pictograms and bar charts, solving problems relating to data handling
- Division - missing number multiplication/division facts, formal written methods for division, dividing by 10, 100 and 1000
- Measurement (perimeter and area) - finding the perimeter of 2D shapes, counting squares for area, multiplying for area

### English

- Poetry - looking at the key features of poetry, exploring specific forms of poetry, writing our own poems about the rainforest
- Newspaper reports - identifying the key features of newspapers, distinguishing between fact and opinion, reading the story of Juliane Koepcke (an Amazon survivor) and reporting on the incident that took place

### SPAG

- Punctuating direct speech
- Converting nouns and adjectives into verbs using suffixes
- Plural nouns and determiners
- Adverbs and modal verbs
- Singular and possessive apostrophe use

### Science

Electricity - looking at the components of a circuit, creating simple series circuits, identifying whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, looking at conductors and insulators and engaging in scientific enquiry
