Write about your favourite part of Laches Wood. Think about what you enjoyed the most and what you learnt from your experiences? How did it help you in your everyday life? What fears did you overcome?

Alternatively, you can base it on your Easter break.

Make an interactive map of the Nile using software such as, Word, Paint or Minecraft.

➤ **Your map must include:**

A compass.

An accurate representation of the River Nile.

Key cities and points of interest along the River Nile in Egypt.

A key.

➤ **You could use:**

The internet.

An atlas.

- Practise the spellings given to you by your teacher each week
