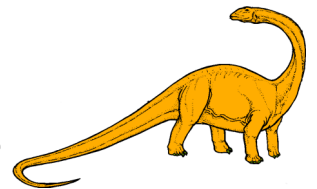
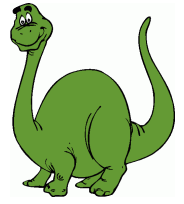


Reception Newsletter— Friday 9th March 2018
