Music

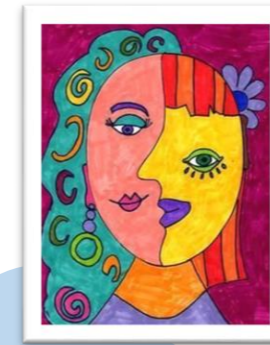
- Hey You! (*Charanga - Year 1 unit*) - Learning about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and enjoy rap in its original form

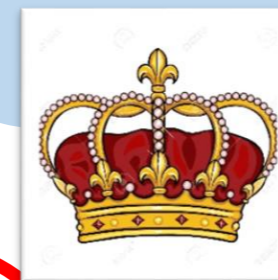
