Fine motor: cutting items using scissors to glue for a medical bag, using tweezers, play dough.

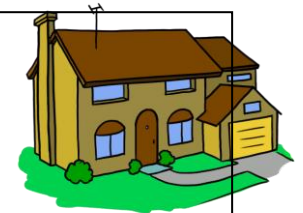

Mathematics

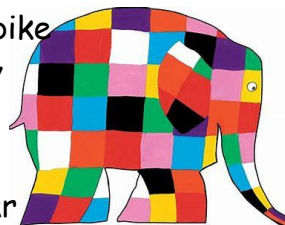
Number songs
