Using technology to find information about arctic animals.

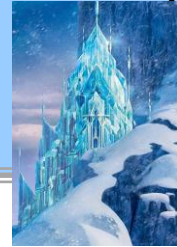


Physical Development

Team games: working in groups, following instructions

Mathematics

Reciting numbers between 0 and 20 starting at different points.

Ordering numbers to 10/20 starting at different points and with random numbers
Ordinal numbers—1st to 10th.

Counting reliably up to 10 and 20 objects.

2D shapes—shapes in snowflakes

3D shapes—making a winter vehicle

Addition and subtraction through games.



Communication and Language

Literacy

Texts: Henry's Holiday; non-fiction books about Winter and arctic animals; Olaf's Frozen Adventure; One Little Penguin and His Friends; The Polar Bear and the Snow Cloud; Bella gets her Skates On

Writing labels, sentences, captions and sentences.

Using Set 1 and Set 2 RWI sounds.

Sequencing story events.

Phonics: using Fred Talk to read words; using Fred Fingers to break words into their sounds; reading and spelling some tricky words.
