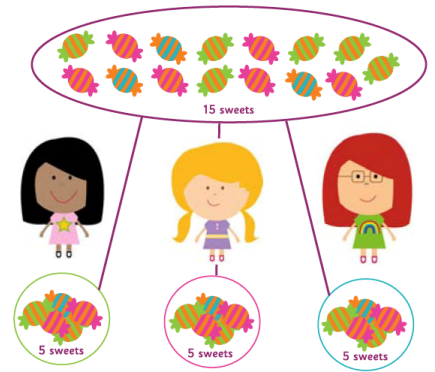

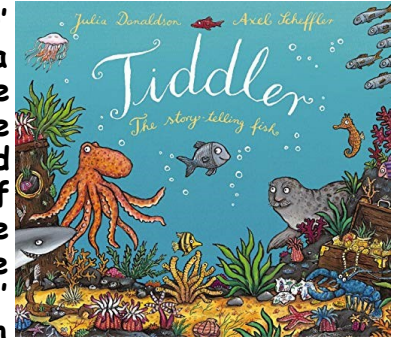

Our Learning this week:

- In Maths this week we have been learning about sharing. We have learnt that sharing means sorting a given amount of objects into two or more equal groups. We have learnt that equal means the same. Throughout the week we have used a variety of resources to help us with our learning on sharing such as number cards, toys, counters and shells/buckets.



- This week we have continued with our 'Under the Water' theme with our learning on 'Tiddler' a story all about a little fish who makes excuses for why he was late. We have really enjoyed engaging in lots of sea creature activities. We have created puffer fish paintings; cut and stick mermaids; fish collage artwork and have had lots of fun reading, writing and creating our own sea creature stories in our 'Water World' themed role-play.
