### REMOTE LEARNING

Following a trial this week, we are changing the way we will be delivering remote learning for those children in isolation who are asymptomatic.

If your child tests positive for Covid-19 and is unwell, please let us know as they must rest and do not need to participate in remote learning. However, if your child is well/asymptomatic and can participate in remote learning, we will now be using a blended approach as follows:

- Each day, after school, your child's class teacher will email you with the work for the next days lessons and also a Teams link.
- All work will need to be printed out for your child to access in the lessons. If this is not possible, please notify the school office when reporting your child's absence.
- At 9:00 am, 10:50 am and 1:15 pm your child will need to join the lesson via the Teams link sent.
- We ask that parents/carers do not communicate with the teacher during the lesson as they will also be teaching the rest of the class who are in school.

We hope that this blended approach will further improve our remote learning offer and ensure that children at home get the benefit of their teacher's expertise.

## ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Recently there has been a decline in children's absences being reported to the school office in the correct way.

**It constitutes a SAFEGAURDING concern if the office do not have any contact regarding your child's absence.**

### ALL ABSENCES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE BEFORE 9.30am.

If your child is absent and the school have had no form of communication, it is the school's statutory duty to call First Response and your child's absence will be unauthorised.

When reporting your child's absence, please ensure that you notify the office staff of the reason. If they are unwell, please ensure that you detail basic information about their illness, eg stomach bug, high temperature, etc.

## IMPORTANT - Kids Club

Booking rules for Kids Club:

- \* Kids club **MUST** be booked **24 hours in advance.**
- \* **NO ON THE DAY BOOKINGS** - (Only in certain circumstances which have been approved by Miss Sweet, this would also include an additional charge of £2 each child.)
- \* Payment has to be made **within 1 hour** or any booking will be cancelled.
- \* A late collection after your booked time, can result in an additional fee of £5 per child.
- \* If you no longer require your booked session, you must cancel it yourself and your account will be credited the correct amount.

***Our after school provision is now very busy and we may not be able to accommodate all late bookings.***

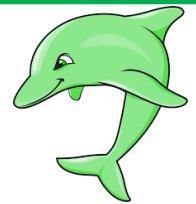

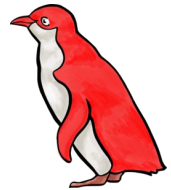
