Our learning this week:

- This week we have enjoyed our new topic 'Winter Wonderland' learning all about 'Frozen'. We have created snowflake repeating patterns, drawn and painted ice palaces for Elsa, created collage and cut and stick Olaf's, played with ice cubes and had great fun dressing up and acting out the Frozen story in our 'ice castle' role-play area.
- In maths this week we have been learning about 'sharing'. We have learnt what the words 'equal' and 'unequal' mean. We have learnt how to share moving items one at a time to ensure all the groups we are sharing between have the same amount when we are finished. We have shared 'snowballs' between the Frozen characters very carefully to make sure they all have equal amounts to play with.

Please could we kindly ask that, if your child is unable to do their coat up by themselves, this weekend they practice putting their coat on independently.
