Music

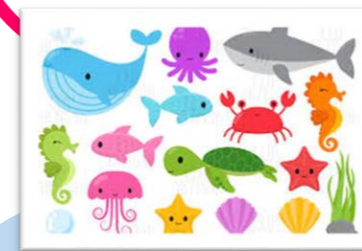
- Friendship Song (*Charanga*) - singing the song, adding choreography and playing instruments
