In line with White Rose scheme.

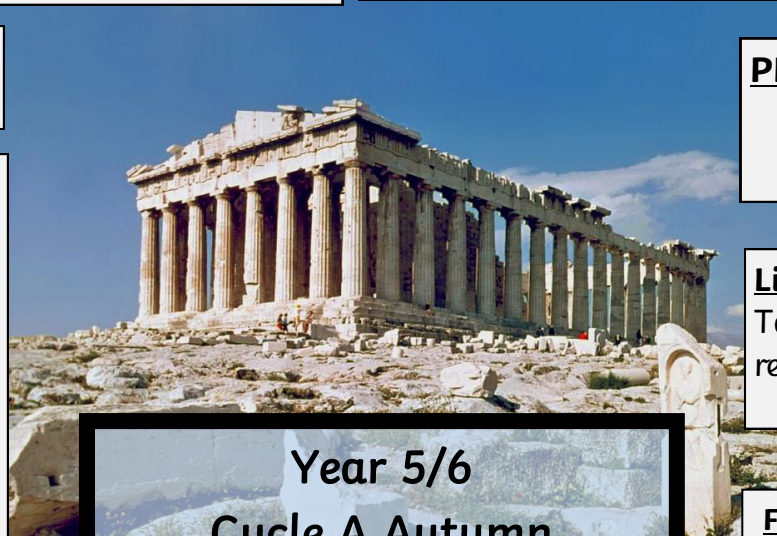
Science:
