

Art and D&T: Focus on perspective, proportion and composition or drawing bodies. Introduced to Henry Moore and his art depicting mass evacuations in the underground. Making bird boxes – designing, making and evaluating using most suitable materials.

History: War and Conflict

What does conflict it mean? Why do wars start? Study how WW1 and WW2 started and who was involved. Find out key facts about major wars. Focus on cause and effect of war — socially, economically, culturally and politically. Understand there are different sources of information and views. Use chronology to describe events. Explore the act of Remembrance celebrated yearly and its importance.

Science

Classification: describe how things are classified according to characteristics. Give reasons for plant and animal classification.

Evolution and Inheritance: Recognise that living things have changed over time, looking for evidence of these changes, recognise that living things have similar offspring, identify how plants and animals have adapted to suit their environments.
