


Reception Newsletter

Our learning this week:

- This week we have continued with our work on the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs'. We have completed lots of work on learning about the key features of story telling such as beginning, middle and end as well as learnt about character descriptions. The descriptive words we used to describe the big bad wolf were fantastic! In our child choice time we have painted pictures of the three houses; used wooden materials to try and create the sturdiest house we can; completed cut and stick three little pigs and written about traditional tales in a brilliant variety of ways.



Messages:

- Please remember it is our trip to Wolseley Bridge garden centre next week on Tuesday 17th May. If your child has not ordered a school packed lunch they must bring a packed lunch with them on the day.

- Can we also please ask that children bring a hat on sunny days to ensure that they are safe in the sun.
