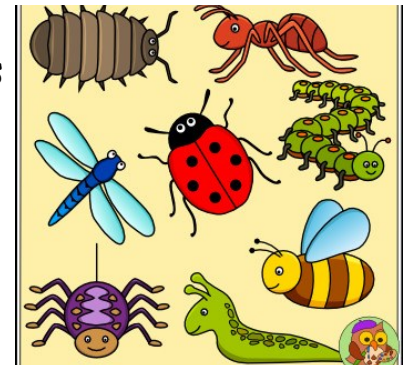
Our Learning:
