Our Learning — Winter Wonderland

• Our KIRF (Key Instant Recall Facts) for this half term is to be able to count forwards and backwards between 0 and 10, starting at different numbers.

E.g. 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10. 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, 0.

- Our focus story this week has been Henry's Holiday by Gillian Shields. It is a beautiful tale about a little penguin who leaves home to find a warmer place. He soon realised that he misses his friends and his Mummy!

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Next Week's Learning:

Next week will be the final week of our Winter Wonderland unit of work. We will be learning about the Aurora Borealis (AKA The Northern Lights!) and looking at the painting by Frederic Edwin Church. We will be painting our own Aurora landscape, whilst exploring how we can create different shades by adding black or white to our paint.

Forest School Kit: Please ensure that your child has full kit each Wednesday, **including wellies**. It can be very cold out in the forest, so it is vital that they have appropriate clothing. Unfortunately, if your child does not have the correct kit, they will not be able to take part.
