Our Learning — Winter Wonderland

- Our KIRF (Key Instant Recall Facts) for this half term is to be able to count forwards and backwards between 0 and 10, starting at different numbers.
- Our focus story this week has been The Runaway Iceberg. Ask your children to tell you about what happens in the story.
- In maths this week, our unit of work was called Alive in 5. We have been investigating zero, representing numbers to 5 and subitising.



Our 'Talk Through Stories' book is One Snowy Night by Nick Butterworth.

Next Week's Learning:

- We will be continuing with the Winter Wonderland theme and will be reading Henry's Holiday.
- We will be finding out lots of cool facts about polar animals and polar regions using nonfiction books.
- In maths, we will be looking at 1 more and 1 less, along with composition of numbers to 5.
