This year, we will again be collecting dried and tinned foods for Christian Food Help, a local charity that we have worked with for many years.

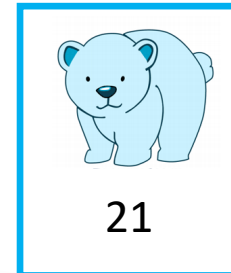
Our fantastic Faith Team have been putting up posters around school to inform the children about why we donate food and when to bring in any contributions.

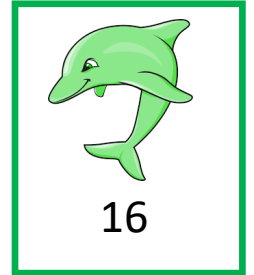

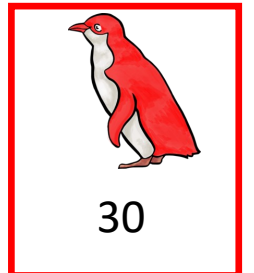
