### Our Learning:

- This week we have enjoyed starting our new topic 'People Who Help Us'. We have started our new topic learning about police officers. We have discussed their job role, how they help us in the community and what we can do in an emergency situation. In our child choice learning time we have: created police badges; collaged police cars; written speeding fines; used transient art materials to create police cars and created our own fingers prints on ink pads which we have studied with a magnifying glass.
- This week we have enjoyed Read Write Inc. lessons. We have learnt 4 new sounds as well as a rhyme to help us to write them:  
i—down the body, dot for the head  
n—down Nobby, over his net  
p—down the plait, up and over the pirate's face  
g—round her face, down her hair and give it a curl
