Our Learning:

- This week we have enjoyed continuing with our topic 'People Who Help Us'. This week we have looked at firefighters. We were lucky to have two firefighters visit our school last Friday to talk to us about their job role and show us a fire engine.
- We have discussed what to do in an emergency and what the emergency number is.
- In our child choice learning time we have: created our own fire engines using the junk modelling, rescued numbers from a pretend fire using the tweezers and looked at a variety of factual and fictional stories about firefighters.
