Have a wonderful half term break and we will see you all back at school on Tuesday 1st November.

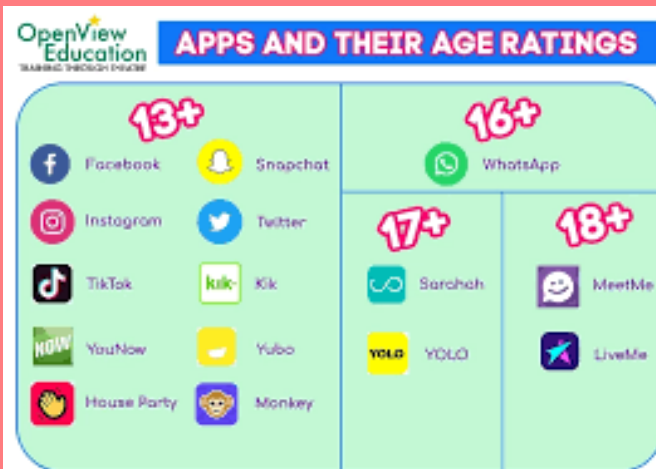
