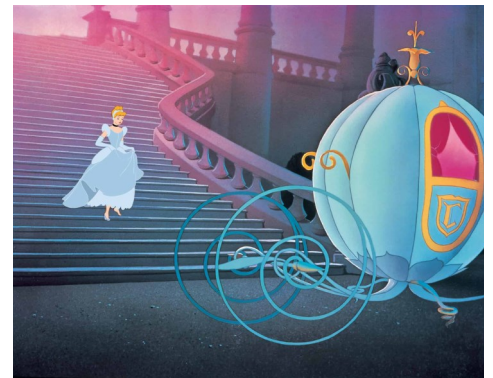


Reception Newsletter
