Our Learning:

- This week we were sent a task of organising a birthday party for Panda Bear (YRC) and Brown Bear (YRH).
- We have been very busy writing invitations to our own cuddly toys, making decorations and creating birthday cards.
- In RWI we have then been reviewing previously taught sounds to embed our learning. Some children have started to read green words and use 'Fred Fingers' to help them write words. Other children have been using magnet boards to help with blending the sounds together.
- In Maths the focus has been number formation for 1, 2 and 3. We have learnt some rhymes to remember them:
 - 1: A downward stroke, my that's fun. Now I've made a number one.
 - 2: Half a heart says "I love you." Add a line. Now I've made the number two.
 - 3: Around the tree, around the tree. Now I've made the number three.



Next week we will start to look at The Nativity Story.
